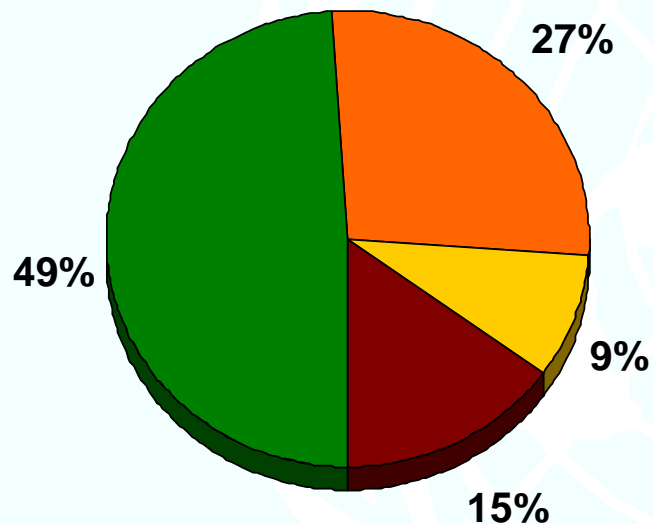


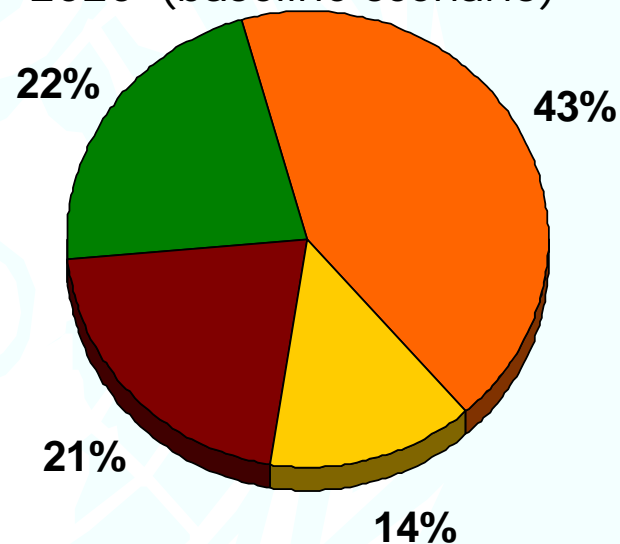
# Global Chronic Disease Burden - 1990-2020

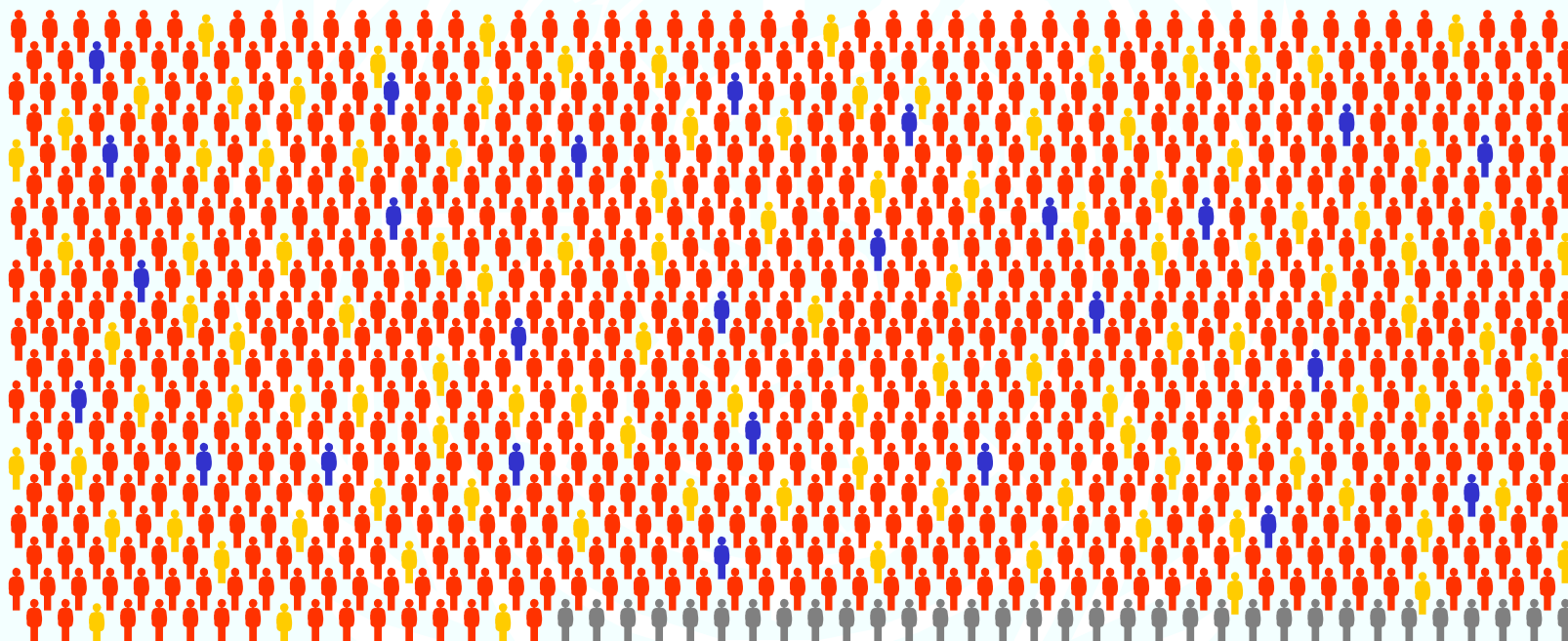

 Noncommunicable conditions (82.9%)

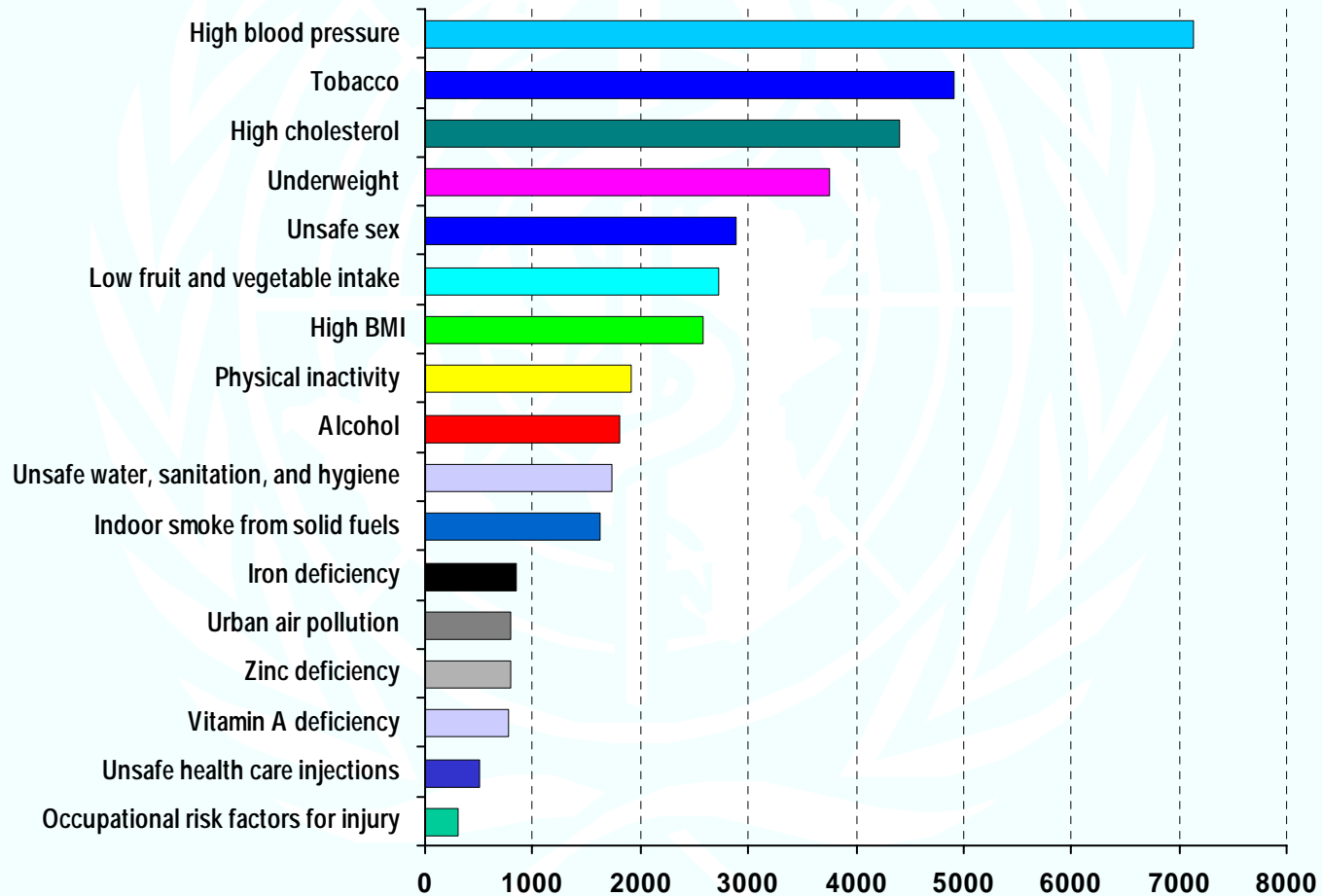
 Injuries (11.2%)

 Undiagnosed (3.3%)



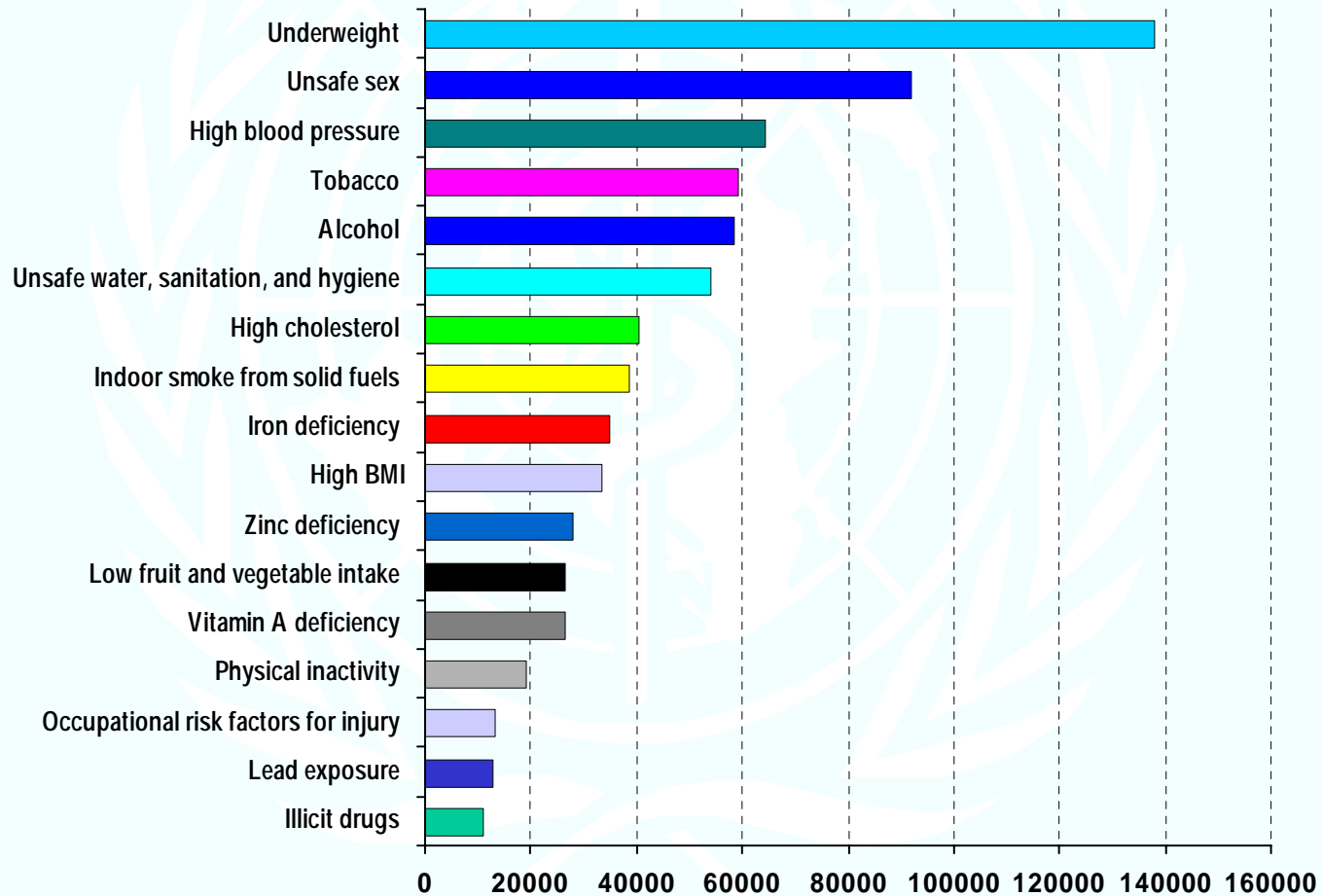

## Attributable mortality in 2000 by selected leading risk factors (000s)



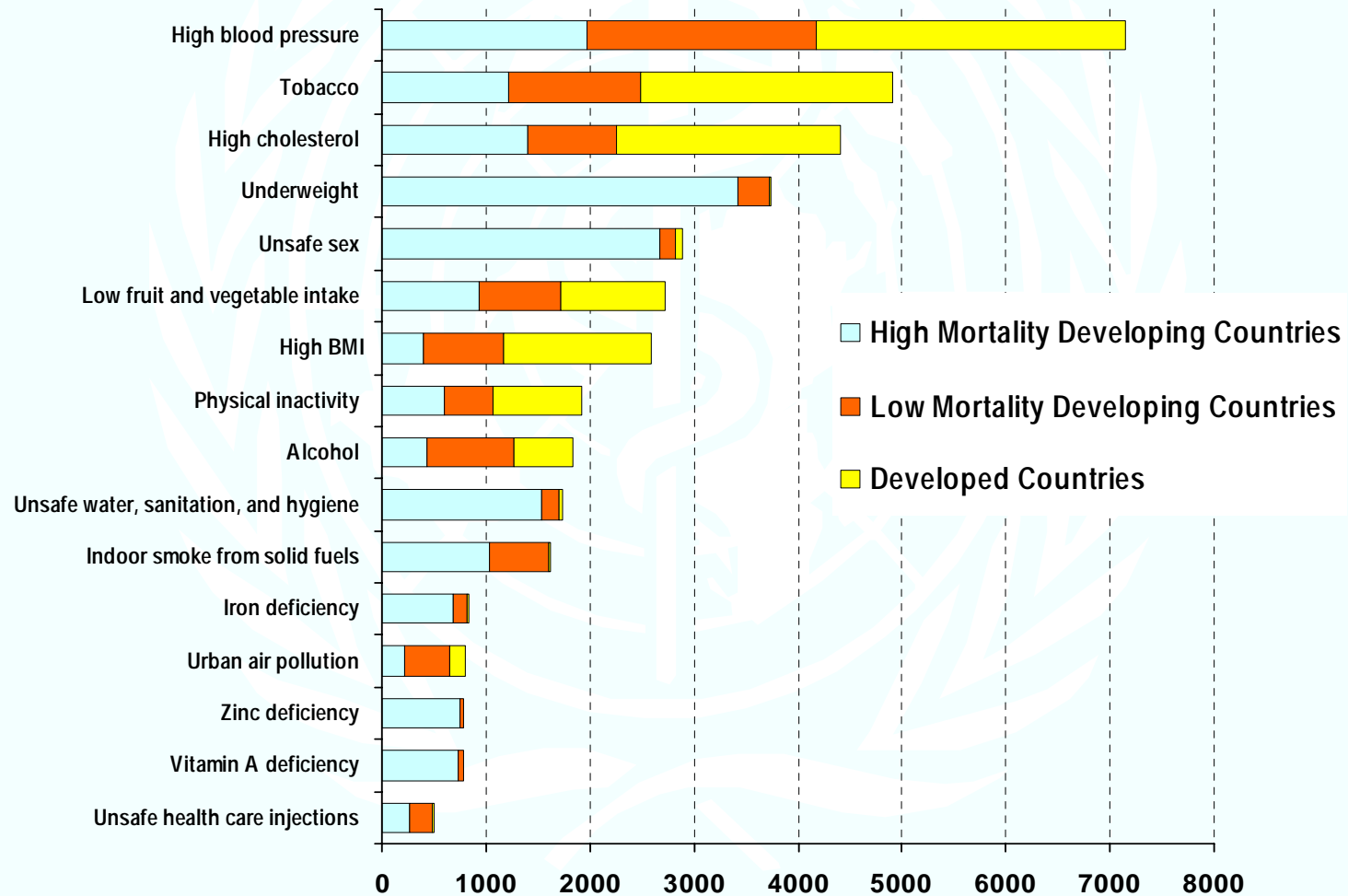

## Attributable DALYs in 2000 by selected leading risk factors (000s)



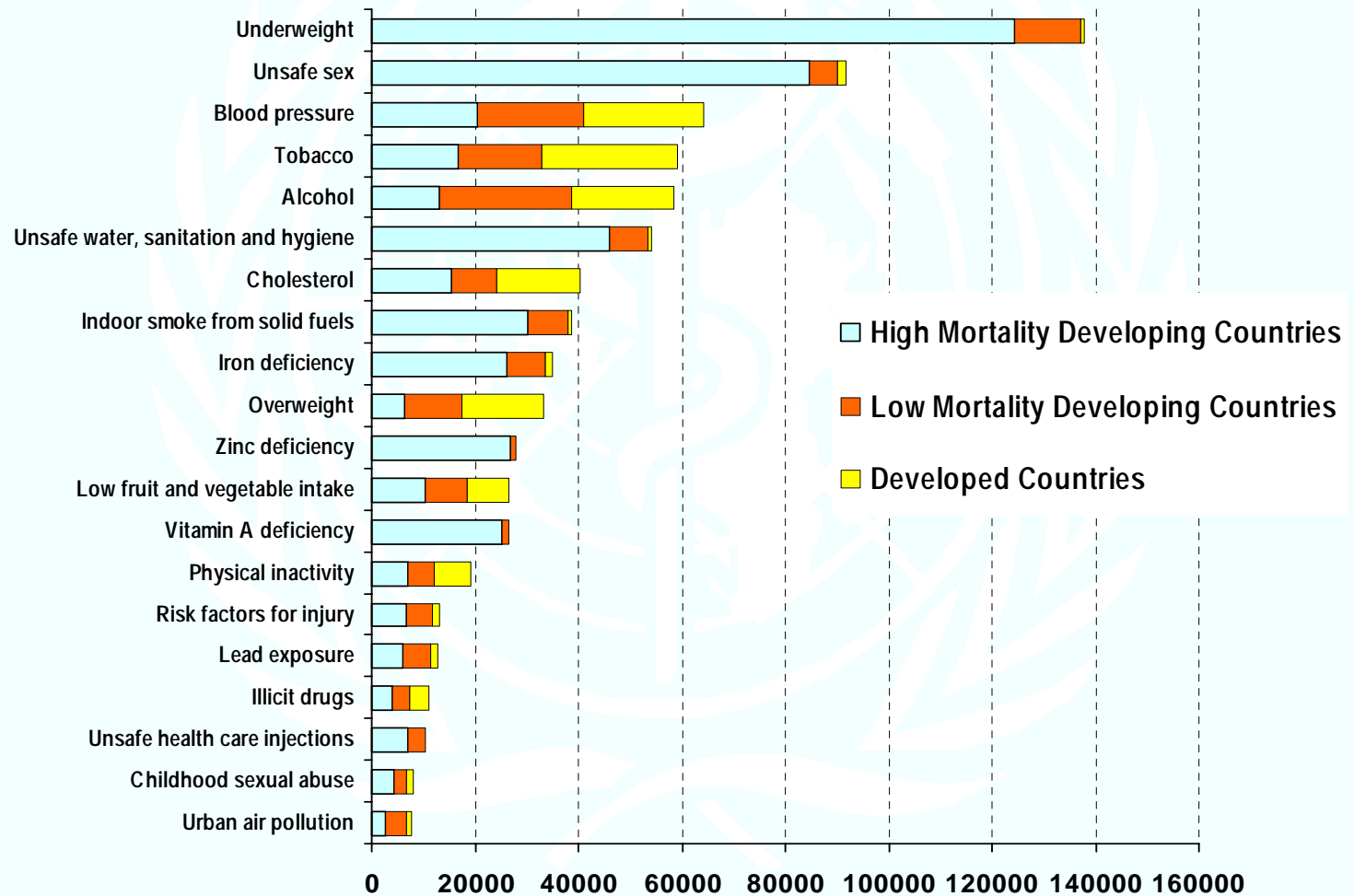

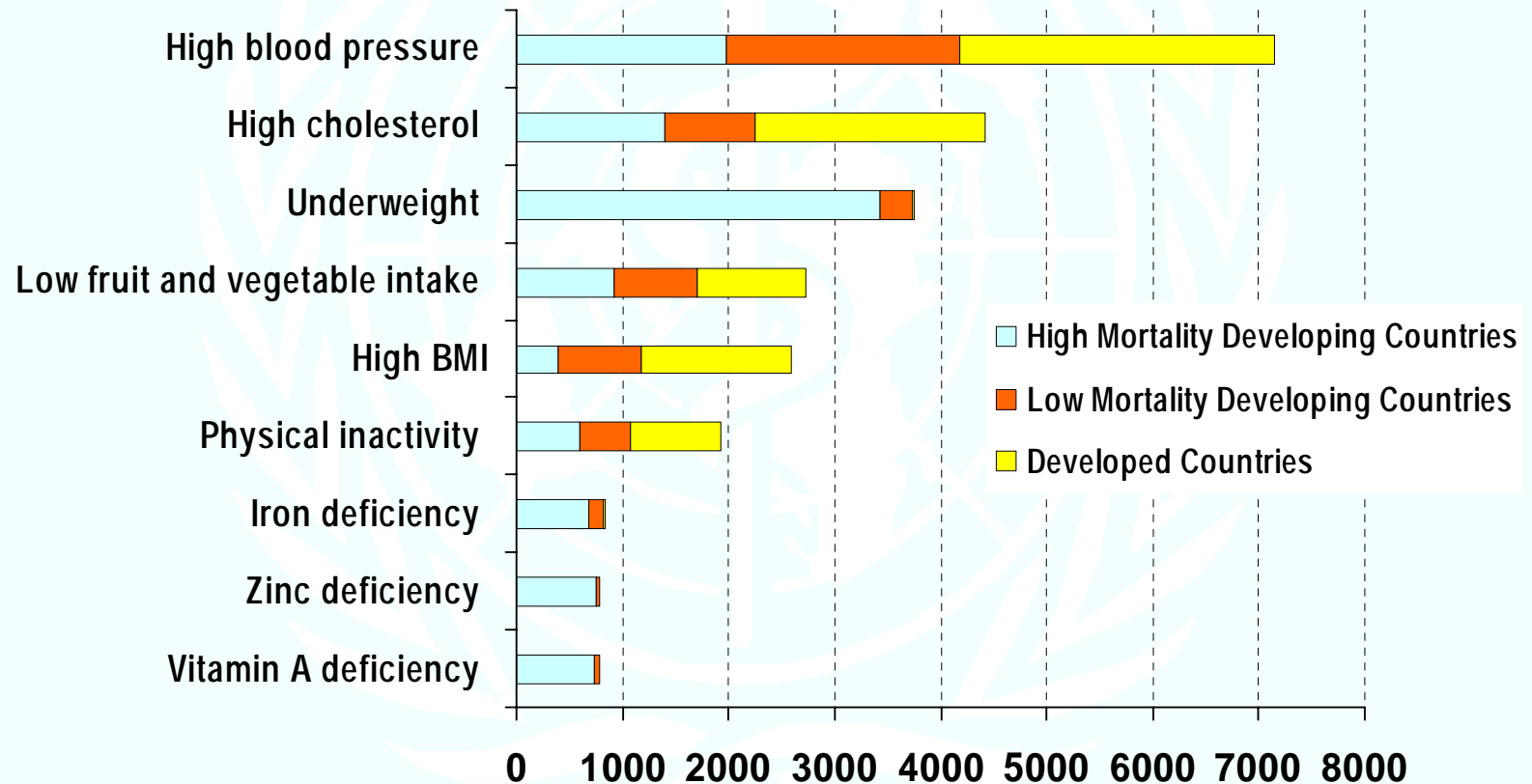
