

WHO Lyon Office: 58 avenue Debourg, 69007 Lyon, France

Arriving by car / by train / by plane

► **By car from Geneva**



After Beynost péage, continue on A42 towards Lyon, then take "Rocade Est" N346 and follow Lyon/Marseille (in green on the above map)

At junction with Grenoble motorway (A43), follow direction Lyon

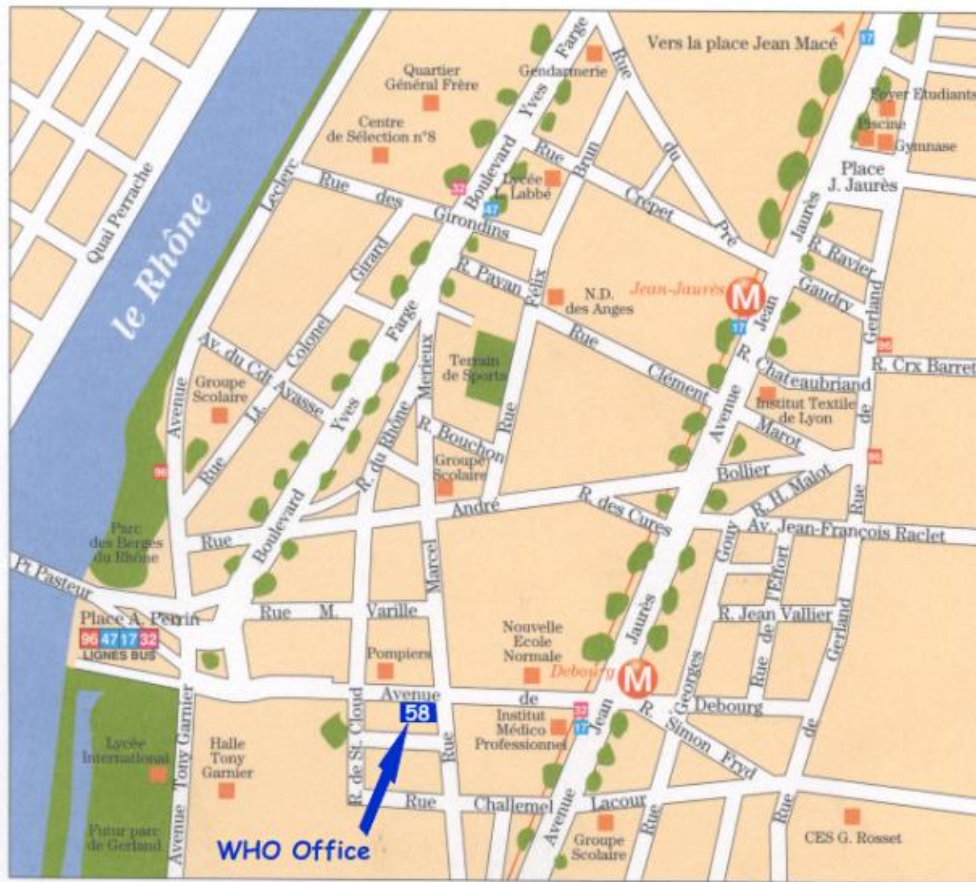
At junction with Périphériques (nord/sud), take périphérique Sud (Marseille)

Leave Périphérique at porte de GERLAND, next exit after Moulin-à-vent

Follow the road round, past McDonald, past Gerland football stadium on your left, to wide junction with big building opposite called **Merial**. Here you leave avenue Jean Jaurès on your right and take the next street on your right in an oblique direction: **Rue Marcel Mérieux**.

Follow along, past restaurants and post office and we are at the set of lights at junction with avenue Debourg. We are the building with red windows at this traffic lights junction.

If you turn right at the lights you will find a car park almost immediately right after the bus stop.

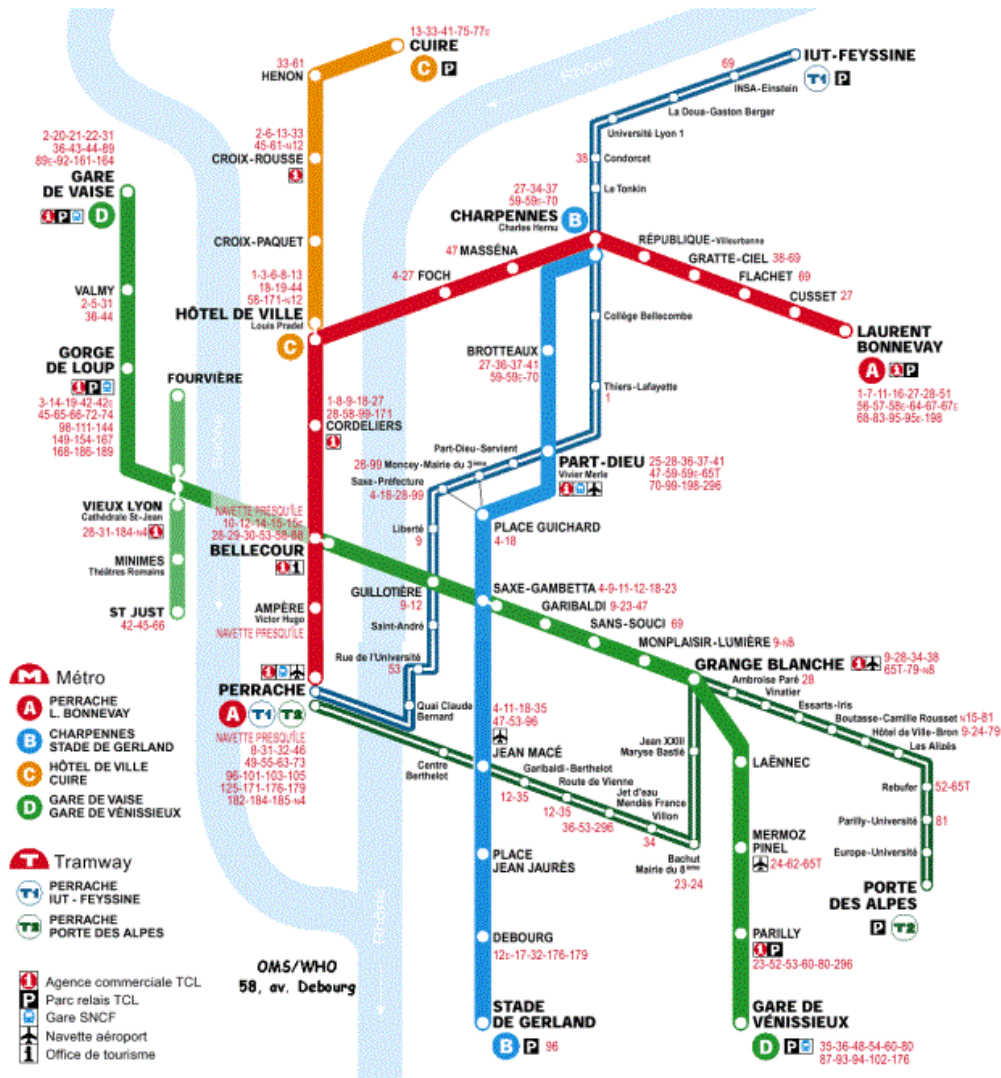


► **By train or by metro**

After a 2 hour train ride from Geneva or from Paris (Gare de Lyon railway station), you will arrive in Lyon either at *Perrache* or at *Part-Dieu* railway station. If possible, get off at *Part-Dieu* railway station. From there, public transportation is the most convenient way to come to the office.

- from *Part-Dieu* railway station: take the B subway line Direction GERLAND and get off at *Debourg* station (see Metro map below)
- from *Perrache* railway station: take the T2 tramway line to *Jean Macé* (2 stops) and then the B subway line Direction GERLAND and get off at *Debourg* station (see Metro map below)
- From *Debourg*, follow Debourg avenue until you reach number 58 and the WHO Lyon Office, at junction with rue Marcel Mérieux.

By plane

The "Antoine de Saint-Exupéry" Airport is located 30 km from Lyon city centre. A bus leaves from the airport every 20 minutes (or 60 minutes in the evening) for the *Part-Dieu* railway station. For more information about this bus, [click here](#).
