General Notes: *Study in 4 different geographic regions: Urban (cities of Dili, Baucau and other smaller district towns), Rural west (Oecussi, Bobonaro and Cova Lima Districts), Rural Central (Aileu, Ainaro, Dili, Emera, Liquica, Manufahi and Manatuto Districts), Rural East (Baucau, Lautem and Viqueque Districts); sampling: three-stage stratified cluster sampling method with probability proportionate to size (1. 40 villages within each region; 2. 3 sub-villages from each village; 3. 10 households from each sub-village), 4320 households were selected including 4211 eligible women and 5420 eligible children; inclusion only of ever-married women aged 15-49 yrs and children aged <60 months; Hb determination only for subsample (4098 women and 5029 children); values for other Hb cut-off levels; adjustment for altitude; Hb cut-off level pregnant women not according to WHO recommendations (please see 'Key to the data tables').*
